Weak = Christians who abstained from certain foods and observed special days like Sabbaths, Feasts, Fasting/Prayer days in loyalty to the Law of Moses and Jewish heritage/tradition. It's likely a few Gentiles sympathetic to Jewish ethics joined them.

Strong = _____ Christians + few "liberated" _____ Christians who ate whatever they wanted and ignored these special days, treating every day alike, living out their freedom in Christ from the ceremonial aspects of the Law of Moses.
