The Battle between Spirit and Flesh Introduction



- Our Christian life is a <u>constant battle</u> between the <u>Spirit and</u> <u>the Flesh</u>
 - □ Galatians 3:3, "Are you so foolish? Having <u>begun by the Spirit</u>, are you now being <u>perfected by the flesh</u>?"
- Spirit has given us all we need to defeat sin
 - Regenerated us ... Lifted us ... gifted us the FRUIT
 - Then 2 Peter 1:3, "... His divine power has granted to us <u>everything pertaining to life and godliness</u>, through the true knowledge of HIM who called us by His own glory and excellence."
- So, if we <u>know</u> ... then, <u>WHY</u>?
 - Rom 7:24, "Wretched man that I am! Who will set me free ...?"

The Battle between Spirit and Flesh The Flesh



- Does this thought "torture" you?
- □ Sin is our biggest problem What causes Sin?
- Flesh (sarx) Body, mind, feelings, human effort. Unredeemed humanness.
- John MacArthur: "The <u>FLESH</u> is at the <u>root of all sin</u> of every form: all <u>wrong emotions</u>, all <u>wrong attitudes</u>, all <u>wrong</u> <u>actions</u>, all <u>wrong reactions</u>, all <u>wrong thoughts</u>, all <u>wrong</u> <u>words</u>, and all <u>wrong deeds</u>. <u>All</u> come <u>out of the FLESH</u>".
- Because FLESH is the Cause of our SINS
 - We must find a means to subdue the Flesh
 - And that means is the Holy Spirit

The Battle between Spirit and Flesh **1. The Command**



- □ <u>The Command with its POWERFUL Promise</u>:
 - □ Galatians 5:16, "But I say, <u>walk by the Spirit</u> ... and <u>you will not</u> <u>carry out the desire of the flesh</u>."
- Can this be the <u>answer to our problems</u>?
 - "Walk" ... keep on ... one step at a time ...
 - □ "By the Spirit" ... follow His lead ... His Trail ... in submission
 - □ <u>How</u>? In the Word and in Prayer
 - Putting OFF the old ... Putting ON the new
 - Being Sanctified more like Christ ... less like world
- John MacArthur: "This little 16th verse is <u>monumental</u>. You can take <u>all the commands of the NT</u> and <u>reduce them to this</u>.
 <u>WALK BY THE SPIRIT</u> and <u>you WILL NOT</u> carry out the lusts of the flesh. <u>That's Victory</u>!"

The Battle between Spirit and Flesh **2. The Conflict**



- Easy? NO! Galatians 5:17 tells us, "For the <u>flesh sets its</u> <u>desire</u> against the Spirit, and the <u>Spirit</u> against the flesh; for these are <u>in opposition to one another</u>".
 - Desire epithumia means "evil yearning".
 - Flesh wants to <u>conceive and bring forth sin</u> Spirit wants to <u>prevent that</u>. Whatever Spirit wants to do – Flesh endeavors to stop. The <u>war is on</u>. That's the <u>Conflict</u>.
- Flesh has two powerful allies the world and the devil
 - Constant barrage ... and we fall for it ... AGAIN!
 - Yet ... no sin ever delivers on its promise
- Sadly, we know, many times too late, The <u>Holy Spirit</u> is <u>stronger</u> that the FLESH ... world ... devil

The Battle between Spirit and Flesh **3. The Contrast**



- Paul contrasts life lived both ways:
 - Galatians 5:19-21 Deeds of the Flesh:
 - Each is a sin
 - "... those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of <u>God</u>"
 - □ Galatians 5:22-23 Fruit of the Spirit:
 - "... love, joy, peace, patience ... self-control ..."
 - " ... and <u>against such things there is no law</u>."
 - These nine virtues are God's will for man
 - □ No law can produce these virtues by self-effort
- Everything wrong in life (sin) is produced by Flesh
- Everything right in life is produced by the Spirit

The Battle between Spirit and Flesh **4. The Conclusion**



- □ Galatians 5:24, "Those that <u>belong to Christ Jesus</u> have <u>crucified the flesh</u> with its passions and desires."
 - Past tense already done <u>positionally</u>
 - Power is broken You <u>can say No</u>!
- □ Galatians 5:25, "If we <u>live by the Spirit</u>, let us also <u>Walk</u> <u>By The Spirit</u>."
- Your SELF is your own Worst Enemy
 - Matt 16:24. "... he must <u>deny himself</u> and <u>take up his cross</u> and <u>follow me</u>."
- Only source of Spiritual Transformation is the Holy Spirit
 - No Human Solution can defeat Sin
 - You want the abundant life? WALK BY THE SPIRIT!
