**Romans 2:4** Or do you presume on the riches of his **kindness** and forbearance and patience, not knowing that God's kindness is meant to lead you to repentance?

#### Hebrew

kindness קָּמֶד chesed

The state or quality of being kind, in any of its various senses; manifestation of kind feeling or disposition beneficence.

**Prov. 21:21** Whoever pursues righteousness and **kindness** will find life, righteousness, and honor.

### **Greek**

kindness χρηστότης chrēstotēs (khray-stot'-ace) the quality of being helpful or beneficial, goodness, kindness, generosity

**Col. 3:12** Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,
