

Topic 5 - The Time of Jacob's Trouble - Daniel's 70th Week - part1

God will intervene on behalf of one nation, that nation is Israel.

Initial Birth Pains:

More serious Birth Pains:

- Tribulation
- Betrayal (apostasy) by those who claim to be in the kingdom
- Saints being put to death
- Anti-Semitism is on the rise again and Israel is hated by all nations.
- Love of many will grow cold.
- Lawlessness to increase

Matthew 24 verses 37-41 are NOT referring to the rapture.

In the context, those taken are taken in judgment.

Revelation 5

This scroll is the delegation of authority (lawful dominion) over the earth. Dominion was granted to man (Adam) at the creation, but Satan deceived Eve and Adam rebelled and fell. In doing so man (Adam) lawfully transferred this authority to Satan.

John weeps as he recognizes Satan's dominion of the earth will not end and man cannot regain that dominion unless a man is found worthy to open the scroll.
