Week 14 Mark 11:1-26 Triumphal Entry & Temple Cleansing

Main Truth - Jesus judges false faith that refuses repentance and rejects Him.

1. Jesus Coronation as King – Mk 11:1-11

Principle: Jesus requires and deserves holy, humble worship.

Applications: Whose praise is on your lips? What is displeasing to Jesus that must be driven out of you?

2. Jesus' Kingdom Purification Mk 11:12-26

Principle: Holiness and purity of life are required and Spirit-enabled.

Applications: What in my life does Jesus need to cleanse? How do I respond when God reveals sin in my life? What fruitlessness will I bring to Jesus for restoration? How have you seen answered prayer as the fruit of faith in God?

- 2. How are the donkey & colt detail significant as God's plan for His Son unfolds?
- 3. How do you praise Jesus only with the crowd, or are you willing to be His disciple when everyone else is silent?

- 5. What did Jesus do to cleanse the temple? Why was He so angered by what He saw?
- 6. What does the temple scene teach you about Jesus? Does anything surprise you?
