WE TEACH that every person, including those engaged in sexual immorality, must be given compassion, love, kindness, respect, and dignity. Hateful and harassing behavior or attitudes directed toward any individual are to be repudiated and are not in accord with Scripture or the doctrines of the Church (1 Timothy 1:5).

WE TEACH that the faithful proclamation of the Scripture, including the call to repentance, does not constitute hate speech, or hateful and harassing behavior, but is instead a fundamental part of the Church's loving mission to the world (Matthew 28:16–20; 2 Corinthians 5:11–20; 2 Timothy 4:1–2).

DIVORCE: WE TEACH that God hates divorce, permitting it only where there has been sexual immorality (Malachi 2:14–16; Matthew 5:31-32; Matthew 19:9) or desertion (1 Corinthians 7:12–16).

WE TEACH that remarriage of the divorced believer to a believer is permitted, but only when the divorce was on biblical grounds. A prior divorce does not necessarily disqualify a man as an elder or deacon (1Timothy 3:2, 1 Timothy 3:12).
