“Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts,

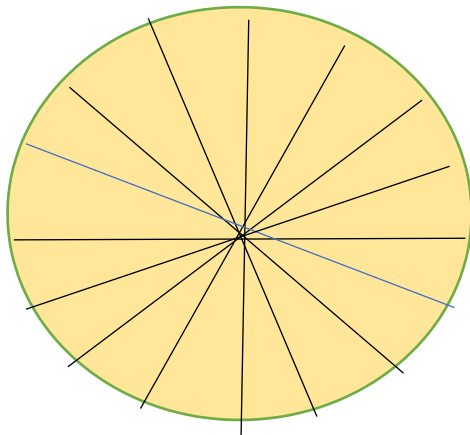
