

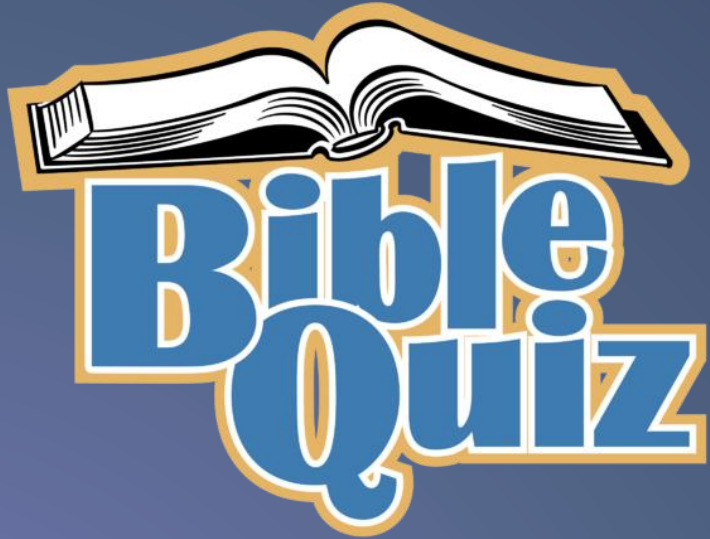

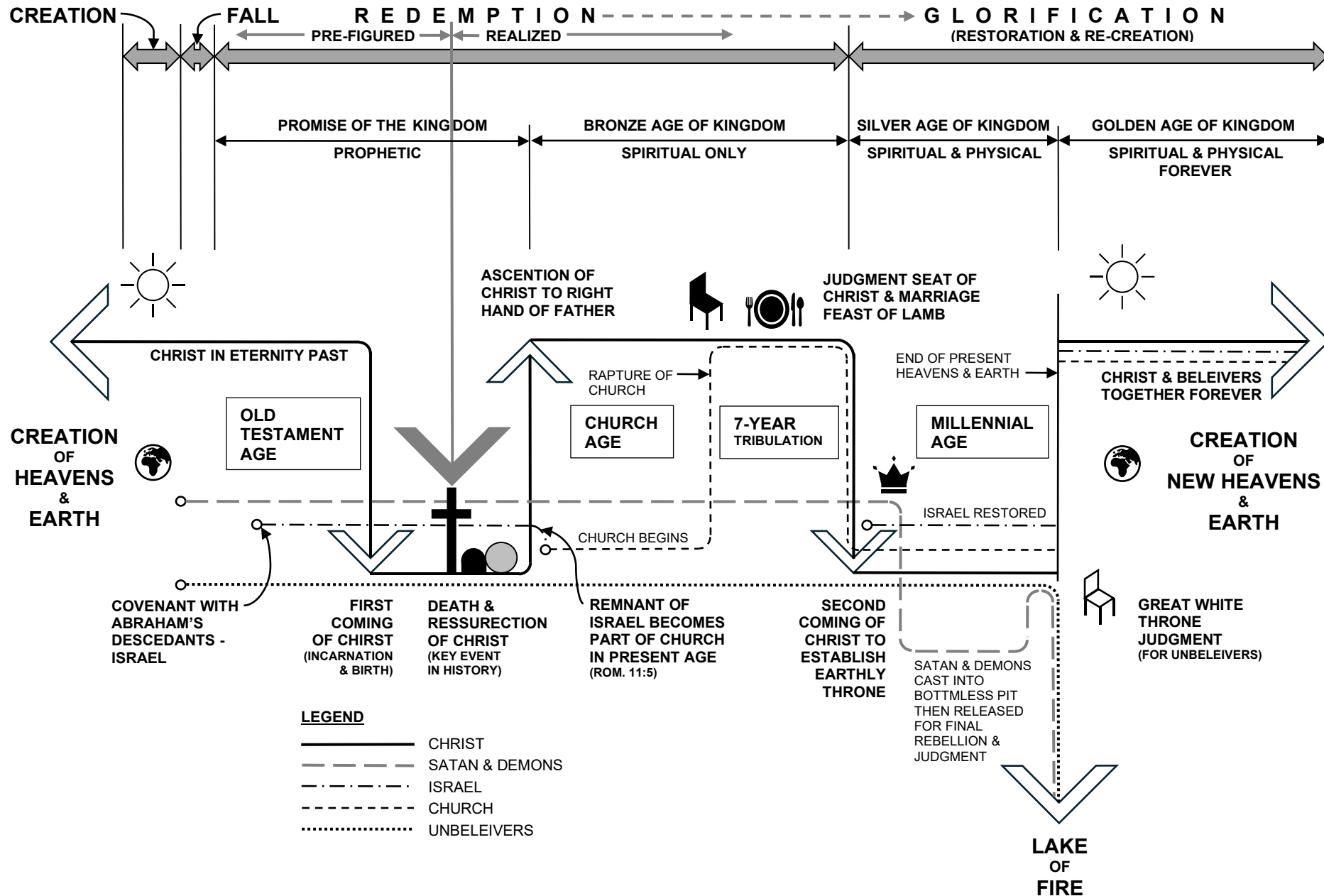

Q: Does the Bible command sinners to be born again?

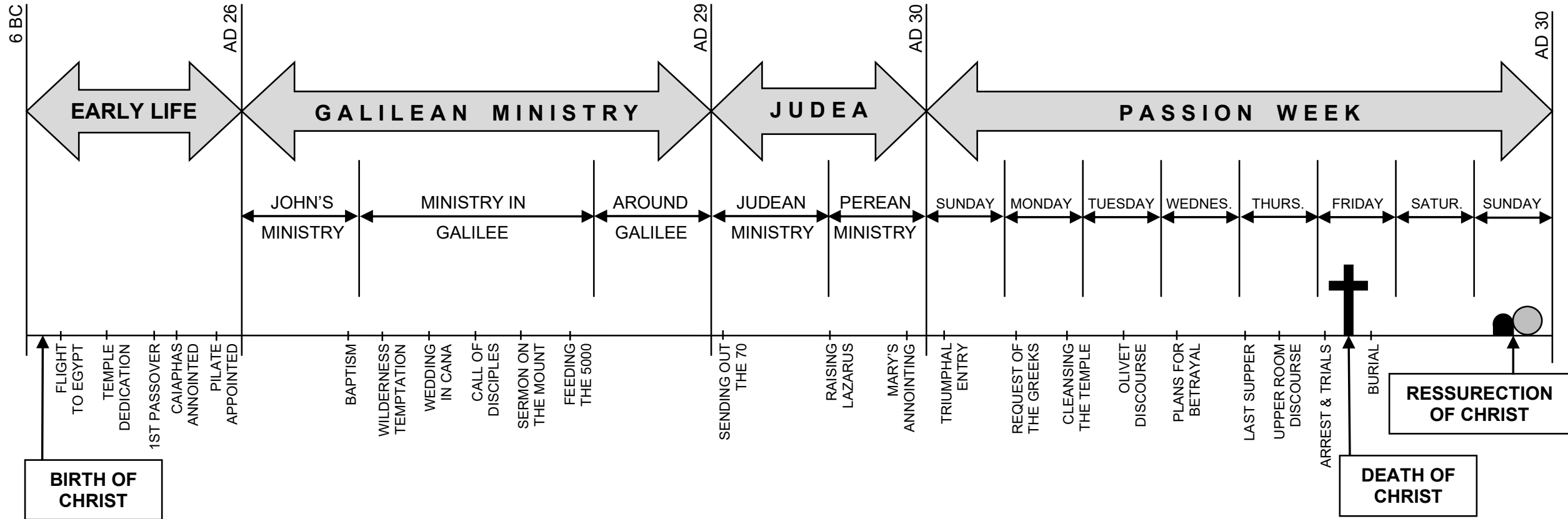

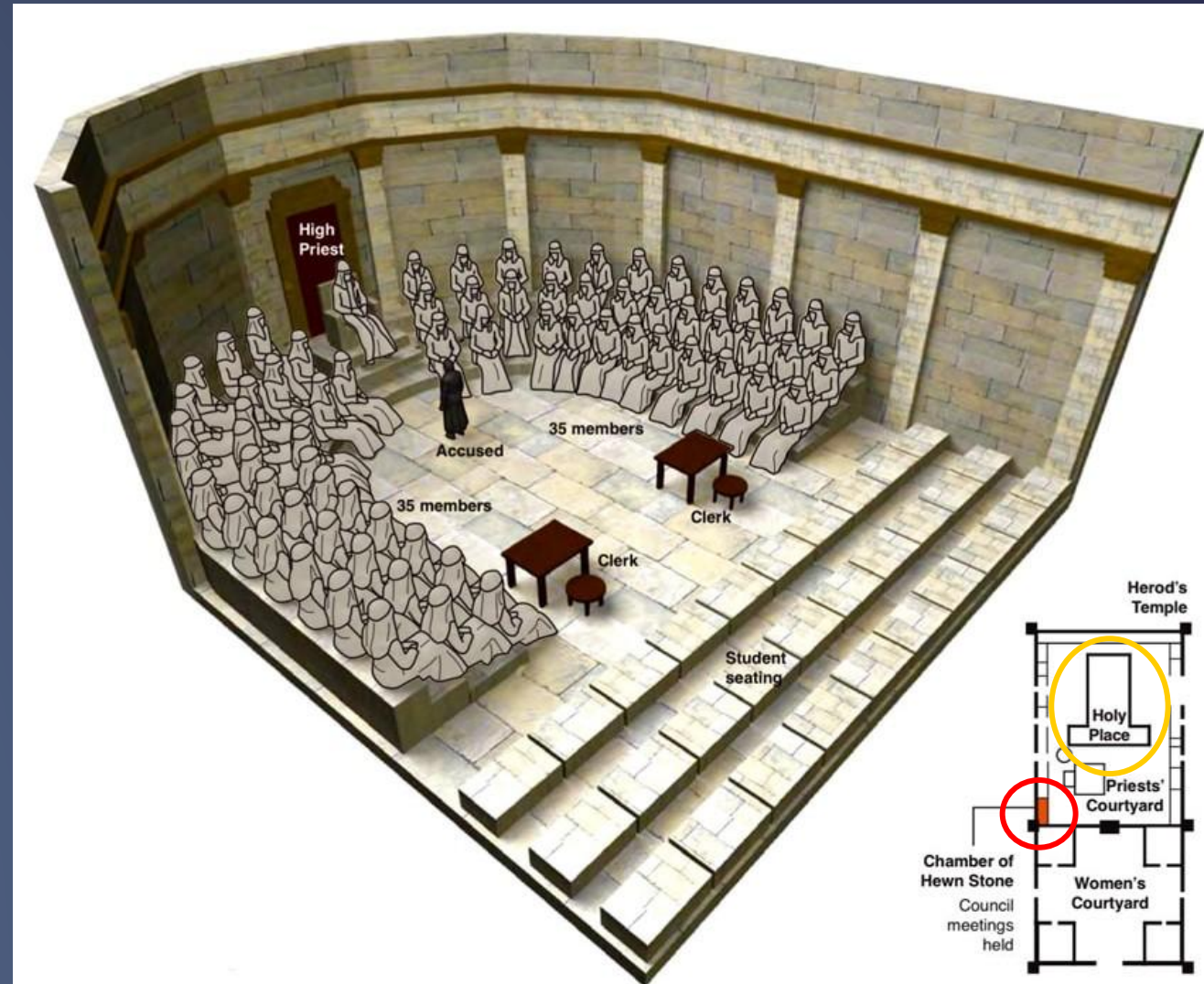
