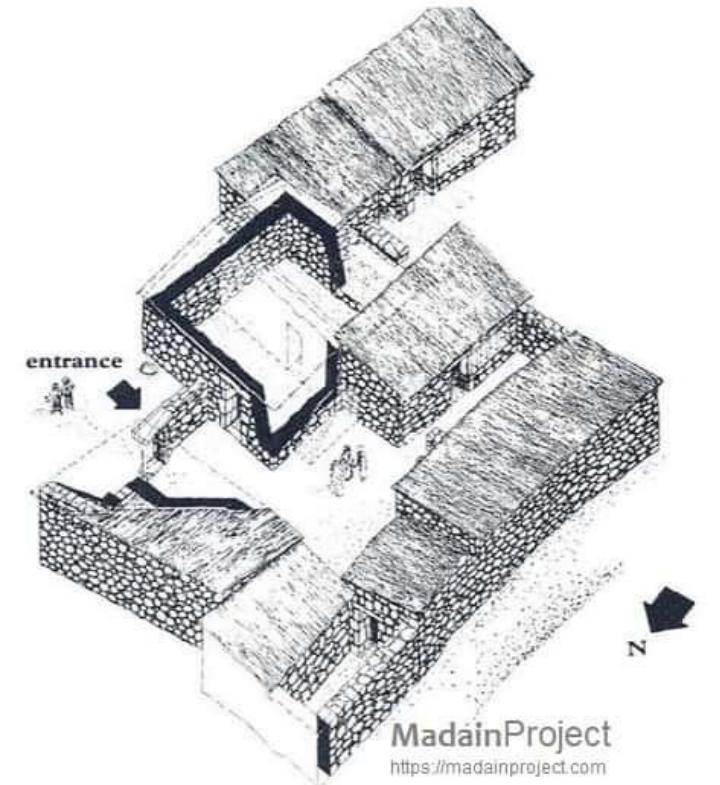

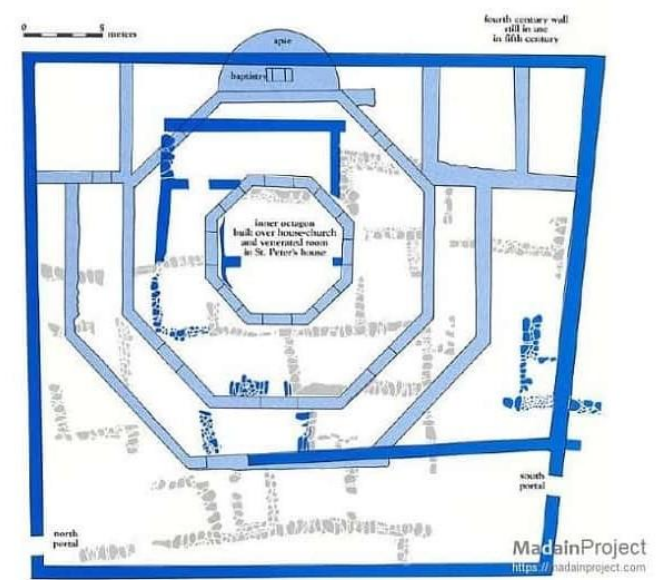
The Sea of Galilee is 8 miles wide by 13 miles long and sits at an elevation of 700 ft. below sea level, making it the lowest fresh water lake in the world.

The region around the lake had a population of around 200,000 in the first century.
