

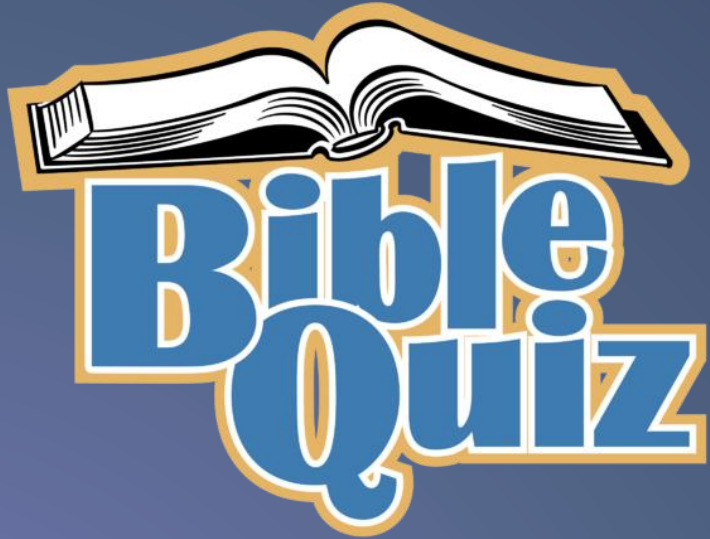

Q: Why do you suppose Moses and Elijah appeared with Christ at His transfiguration?

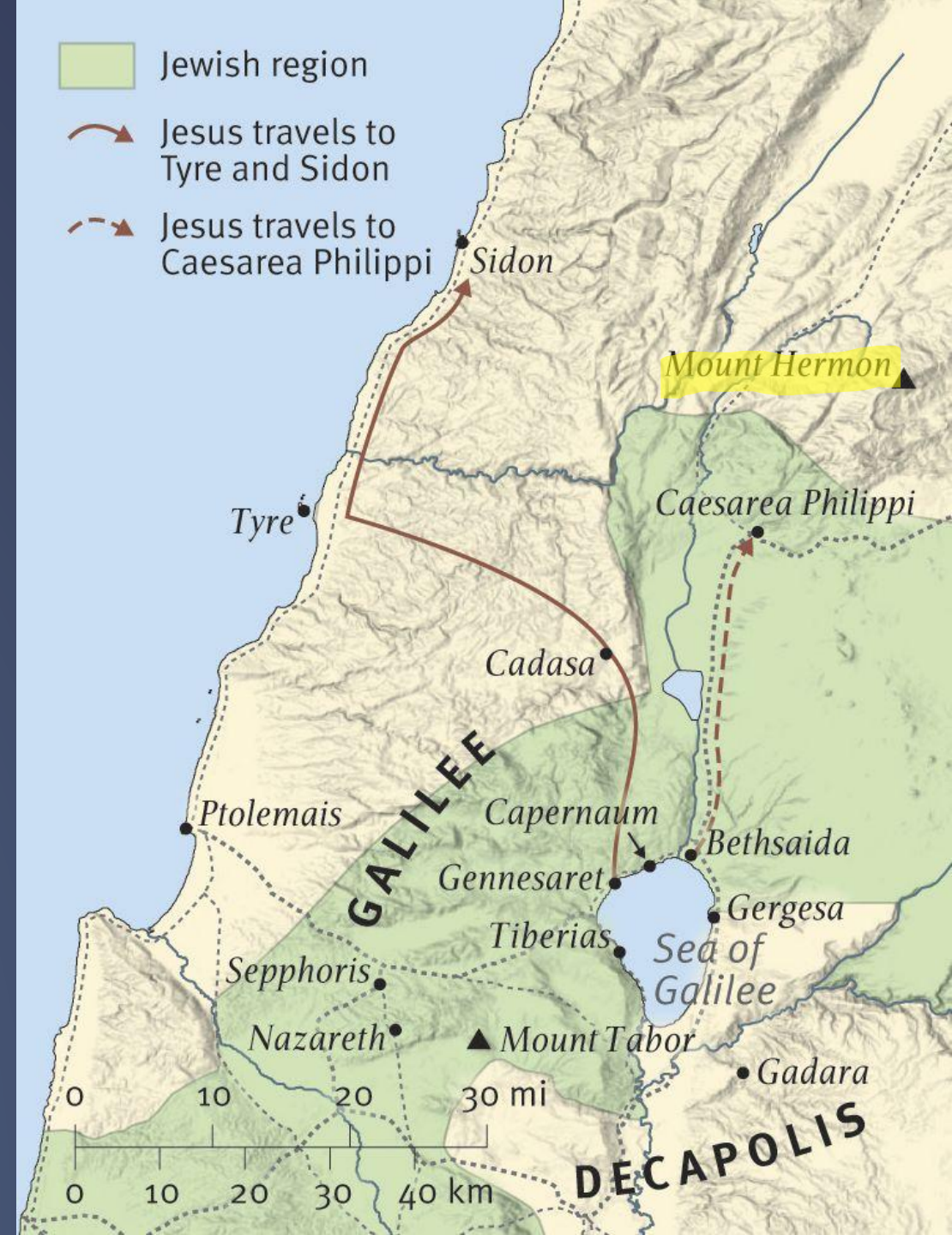
A: (1) They represent the Law (Moses) and the Prophets (Elijah) in pointing to Christ as the fulfillment of God's plan of redemption (Matt. 5:17-18; Luke 24:25-27).

(2) Each had similar a mountaintop encounter with the glory of God in the OT (Exod. 34:5-8; 1 Kings 19:8-18).

(3) Each had a unique departure to heaven that parallels Jesus' ascension (Deut. 34:5-6; 2 Kings 2:11).

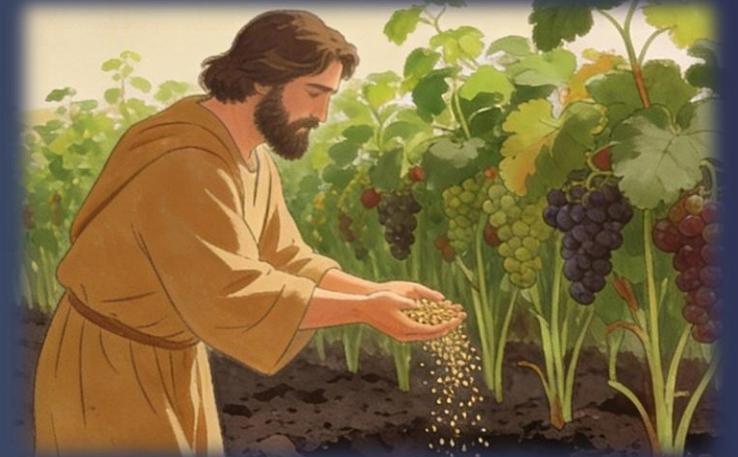
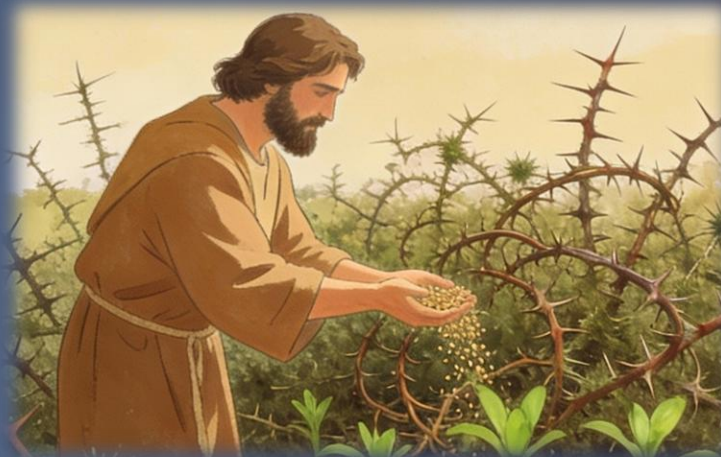
#18 THE LATER MINISTRY OF CHRIST IN GALILEE
