Key events noted in lesson:

- 313 Emperor Constantine and Emperor Licinius issued the Edict of Milan
- 380 Emperor Theodosius issues the Edict of Thessalonica (makes Nicene Christianity official state religion)
- 438 Theodosius II released the codex Theodosianus
- 558 Ferreol the bishop of Uzès in France expelled Jews
- 694 The Seventeenth Church Council of Toledo issues canon #8
- 1096 Pope Urban II authorized the First Crusade
- 1144 Blood Libel against the Jews is falsely claimed in Norwich, England
- 1215 Pope Innocent III convened the Fourth Council of the Lateran
- 1290 Edward I, issued the Edict of Expulsion of Jews from England
- 1475 Blood libel falsely claimed in Trent, Italy
- 1478 The Spanish Inquisition was established by Ferdinand and Isabella
- 1496 King Manuel I of Portugal issued a decree that mandated all Jews either convert to Roman Catholicism or leave the country
- 1516 Venice enacted one of the first ghetto laws requiring Jews to live in a designated area
- 1543 Martyn Luther publishes On the Jews and Their Lies
- 1840 Damascus false blood libel is used against innocent Jews
- 1903 Kishinev pogrom
- 1913 The government of Russian accused a Jewish man of blood libel in the famous Beilis trial

July 16, 1864
