God's Self-existence - Simplicity - Trinity

Aseity - is the quality or state of being self-derived or self-originated; specifically: the absolute self-sufficiency, independence, and autonomy of God. *Merriam Webster*

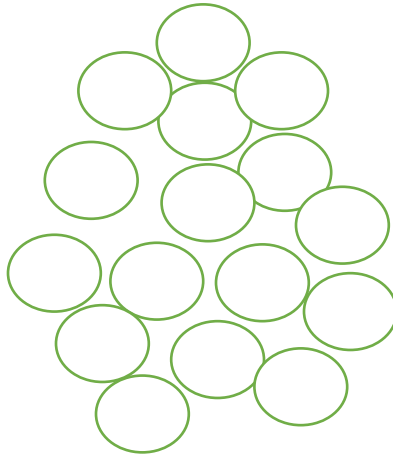
To talk about the aseity of God, then, is to say that God has life from and of himself. He is completely self-originating and dependent on nothing other than himself. In eternity past God was alone, self-contained, self-sufficient, self-satisfied, in need of nothing and no one.

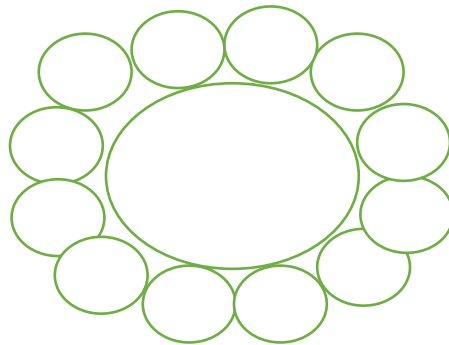
